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Bouchard Père & Fils was founded in 1731 in Beaune, the historic capital of Burgundy wines, and is one of the region's oldest wine houses, perpetuating traditional practices for more than 9 generations and 285 years of history. Managed today by the Henriot family, it offers an extraordinary mosaic of the finest Burgundy appellations: Montrachet, CortonCharlemagne, Beaune Grèves Vigne de l'Enfant Jesus, Volnay Caillerets, Meursault Perrières, etc. The cellars of the Château de Beaune, a fortress built in the 15th century on the ramparts of Beaune, is home to an unrivaled collection of 2,000 bottles from the last century, including legendary wines such as Meursault Charmes 1846, Montrachet 1864, Beaune Grèves Vigne de l'Enfant Jesus 1865... The Henriot Family also has operations in Chablis with Domaine William Fèvre, in Fleurie in the Beaujolais with Domaine Château de Poncié, and of course in Reims with the Henriot Champagne House.

Over the years, Bouchard Père & Fils has built up an exceptional estate, which now extends over 130 hectares of vineyards in the heart of the Côte d'Or, 12 of them are Grands Crus and 74 Premiers Crus. It keeps a close eye over its seven monopolies and exclusivities, remarkable vineyards which receive the attentive care of the teams in charge of viticulture and the maintenance of the estate's vineyards.
